Trustee Seemann explained that the Tribune reported the wrong date for the scheduled work session to discuss a noise ordinance for Bristol Township. Some background for the public is that there has been a complaint about noise at a business within the Township and the suggestion was made to enforce an ordinance to address the complaint.

Trustees wrote a letter to the Trumbull County Sheriff Department to see if they could possibly enforce such an ordinance. The Trumbull County Sheriff Department requested an opinion from the Trumbull County Prosecutors' Office. After receiving all the information it has been decided to hold a public meeting on May 10, 2016 at 7:00 PM in the Administration Building to get the thoughts of Bristol Township residents.

The Trustees explained that they would hear from the residents and consider all their concerns.

Mrs. Gordon reported there have been no certificates issued since the last meeting and that there are two residences building that have not obtained a certificate. She would be sending notices out.

Greg Maraczi Township Supervisor reported that the brakes were insufficient on the 1998, 4900 International Dump Truck, Seal & Drums need replaced.
