#### Old Business

Trustee Webb heard from the Trumbull County Land Bank concerning the house on State Route 88, with the red S10 across from King Bros. They had begun the foreclosure process last fall and it's been delayed due to Covid19. It will continue to move through the courts as the process normally takes about 18 months.

Trustee French reported we are still in the process of doing some repairs of the windowsills on the Town Hall and the Congregational Church.

#### New Business

Trustee Webb had an inquiry about a resident putting up a vegetable stand. The stand would not require a zoning certificate as it is considered agriculture.

Trustee French received a call from a resident reporting a sink hole on Mahan Denman Road near Phelps Road. Mr. Maraczi Township Supervisor will contact the Trumbull County Engineer to look at it, he believes the road will need to be closed for about a week to fix it.

Mr. French moved to give Greg Maraczi authority to close Mahan Denman road if it is deemed necessary by the Trumbull County Engineer to fix the broken culvert causing the sink hole. Mr. Webb seconded the motion.

- Roof has been repaired, GC Metal roofing made a new piece for the peak of the roof and repaired it at NO charge to the fire department. The department sustained wind damage from a storm.

Trustee French reports a house on Mahan Denman Road has been demolished by the Land Bank.

Fiscal Officer report

- Townships are expected to have less of a financial impact than other Governmental Entities.
- Property Tax should remain stable
- Expect and overall reduction of 20% in the Gasoline Tax, Motor Vehicle Tax and the local government tax over the rest of the year.
- State Auditor suggest we plan for an overall reduction of tax dollars by 20% when planning the 2021 budget.

Trustee French reported on phone calls about tall grass. Township really has no authority to tell a property owner to cut their grass but we can notify the Health Department.

Mr. Webb moved to set the next Township meeting on July 7, 2020 at 6:00 PM. Mr. French seconded the motion.
