Culvert Permit Application Policy Bristol Township

- 1. As per ORC 5571.16 any person installing a new driveway culvert, replacing an existing culvert, or installing culvert landscape pipe in a township ditch on a roadway maintained by Bristol Township must complete this application for permit.
 - On roadways maintained by Trumbull County Engineers Office, anyone installing a culvert must apply for a permit through that office.
 - On roadways maintained by the Ohio Department of Transportation, anyone installing a culvert must apply for a permit through the ODOT office.
- 2. The Bristol Board of Trustees shall set the requirements necessary to ensure that water shall travel freely through culverts and basins for the protection of Township roads.
 - The Township Road Supervisor shall represent the trustees.
 - Application shall be made to the Township Fiscal Officer.
 - Normal driveway culvert size is 15" in diameter and 30' in length. However, upon visual inspection by the Trustees or their representative, a larger diameter or longer length of pipe may be required. In some instances of minimal flow, a smaller diameter of pipe may be approved. The Bristol Board of Trustees are responsible for final approval.
- 3. A sketch of the proposed culvert installation must accompany this permit application.
- 4. All pipes must be installed so that bell end of the pipe is upstream.
- 5. Catch basins or cleanouts will be required every 150" or where required by the Trustees on installations spanning long distances.
- 6. All bell joints and "Tie In" joints must be properly sealed.
- 7. All driveway culverts installed must be bedded with a minimum of 12" of slag under the pipe and sides of the culvert. Landscape tile must be bedded with slag also.
- 8. All construction materials, installation methods, and proper traffic control must comply with ODOT specifications, the Ohio Uniform Traffic Code, and the Bristol Board of Trustees.
- 9. All contractors must be properly insured and bonded.
- Failure to comply with the permit requirements is a violation of ORC 5571.16.
 Bristol Township is required to enforce ORC 5571.16.
 ORC 5571.99 states that whoever violates section 5571.16 of the ORC shall be fined not more than \$200.00 or imprisoned not more than 30 days, or both.
- 11. A \$25.00 Permit Fee must accompany this application. Please make checks payable to Bristol Township.
